### Record of Abiana should be made computerized:

#### Chairman SIDA

Provincial Minister Irrigation and Chairman SIDA, Mr. Jam Saifullah Dharejo held an important meeting with the SIDA officials in SIDA Secretariat on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2010. In which, Mr. Muhammad Ehsan Laghari, Managing Director, SIDA, along with Mr. Mohammad Khan



Nizamani Director Left Bank Canals Area Water Board, Mr. Shamil Hingorjo, Project Director, Chotiari Reservoir, all the senior staff members of SIDA Secretariat and others attended the meeting. In this meeting, Mr. Jam Saifullah Dharejo directed that the significant steps should be taken by the SIDA to

increase the recovery of Abiana and the record of Abiana should be made fully computerized. Where as, the cost /price of the water, used for industrial purposes, should be increased. Moreover, it was decided to increase the members of the SIDA Board as per Sindh Water Management Ordinance 2002, as well as to accelerate the running works of Water Sector Improvement Project. On this occasion, Mr. Chair said that there is ban on the direct outlets. He further said that the recovery of the remaining bills from the Provincial and Federal departments/ organizations should be made earlier as possible and the officials of the respective departments be contacted in this regard. The Chair also directed to speed up the remaining work of the Mukki Fursh (floor) scheme in the Chotiari Reservoir and to release the funds urgently.

discontinued. Hence, the rates of commercial users have been enhanced from Rs.1 per thousand gallons to 10 rupees per thousand gallons. The 52<sup>nd</sup> meeting of Left Bank Canal's Area Water Board was held at Hyderabad camp office on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2010 presided over by Mr. Khalil Ahmed Burgri, attended by Mr. Nazir Essani, General Manager Transition

SIDA, Mr. Muhammad Khan Nizamani, Director Left Bank Canal, Water Board Badin, Mr. Ishtiaq Memon, Executive Engineer, Mr. Aftab Ahmed Memon Manager Revenue SIDA, members of Board Mr Nawaz Memon, Nadir Khwaja, Malik Sultan, Mir Fayaz Talpur and others. Mr. Aftab Ahmed Memon, Manager Revenue SIDA informed that Left Bank Canal, Area Water Board Badin has issued a warning notice to Hyderabad Development Authority to recover all the dues of water around Rs.63 millions, otherwise the supply will be discontinued. Mr. Nazir Essani, General Manager, Transition SIDA said to Director AWB send the dues record of water of Federal entities to SIDA, so as to take necessary consultations with the representatives, Mr. Muhammad Khan Nizamani Director AWB informed the meeting that the sand is illegally being taken from Bund areas which should be condemned and actions should be taken with the

coordination of relative district administrations.

### **WASA refuse to pay water dues to LBCAWB**

SIDA & Left Bank Canals Area Water Board Officials held a meeting with M.D, WASA on 8<sup>th</sup> December, 2010 at Civic Center, Hyderabad for the recovery of water dues/Levy taxes, attended by Mr. M. Sharif Arain, M.D, WASA, Mr. Khalil Burgri, Chairman Left Bank Canal, Area Water Board, Mr. Nazir Essani, General Manager, Transition, SIDA, Mr. Aftab Memon, Manager

Revenue SIDA, representative of Director Left Bank Canal, Area Water Board, Sub Division Officer, Khalid Ahmed and board member such as Major (R) Umar Farooq. While meeting Mr. Khalil Burgri updated MD WASA that the institute still did not pay the dues of 63 millions rupees since 1971. Moreover, he has emphasizes on quickly payment, he said that the dedicated water quantity for WASA was 5 cusecs, where as they are enjoying 40 cusecs which is illegal. Mr. Nazir Essani said that SIDA is an autonomous institute for water supply to general public and commercial customers and WASA is one of its large quantity taking customer therefore it should show responsible attitude and to pay all their remaining dues else SIDA keeps the authority to revoke the water supply to WASA. In response, Mr. Sharif Arain, MD WASA said that WASA is in scarcity of financial resources to an extent of even unable to pay salaries to the employees therefore we are unable to pay the

dues. Moreover, SIDA should consult the government of Sindh in this matter and the same will be sent to DG WASA for further consideration.

They informed that at present they are facing difficulty to manage their official matters due to unavailability of office building and shown their interest in construction of new office building.
